Ms. Forrester recognized the staff at the two elementary schools in LAUSD who were recently visited by Government agents and stood up to protect their students. She also recognized LACOE for the Know Your Rights Workshops that have been created to better inform school staff about student rights. She thanked the County Board for supporting and prioritizing students and families.

Dr. Ruth Perez, Deputy Superintendent, provided the following highlights to the County Board:

Division of Special Education

- LACOE's Division of Special Education and the LAAS Unit co-hosted a professional development day, "Designing for All: UDL in Action," focused on expanding inclusive practices through Universal Design for Learning (UDL).
- The event engaged 135 participants from 64 schools and LEAs, spanning preschool to high school. Sessions were well-received and tailored to the diverse audience.
- Post-event surveys showed high satisfaction and strong interest in future topics, including classroom-ready UDL tools, content-specific strategies, co-teaching, and systemwide UDL implementation.
- A follow-up virtual event is scheduled for May 13, 2025.

Career Technical Education Unit Hosting a Symposium

- LACOE's Career Technical Education unit is hosting the Golden State Pathways Program (GSPP) Secondary Symposium, Bridging Education and Industry at Cerritos Community College on May 2, 2025, from 8 a.m.- 4 p.m.
- Participants will discover how to bridge CTE programs and high-growth industry sectors during workshop sessions about GSPP best practices and outcomes, dual enrollment initiatives, and pre-apprenticeship/apprenticeship opportunities.
- The Board is invited to attend and join in the interactive sessions, on-site tours, and networking opportunities, where participants will gain insights and resources to facilitate students' seamless transition from high school to college and career.

Visit to Homeboy Industries

- Yesterday, a team of us visited Homeboy Industries as we take steps toward formalizing a partnership to better support students in our Juvenile Court Schools.
- **Staff Training & Capacity Building:** We're exploring opportunities for Homeboy to support training for our JCS staff—helping deepen understanding of the environments our students come from, and promoting trauma-informed, love-centered approaches to education and engagement.
- **Community Reentry & Student Support:** We're also looking at how Homeboy can play a key role in strengthening reentry pathways for students transitioning back to their communities. It was incredibly powerful to hear directly from students who shared how vital Homeboy has been in their return—providing not just support, but a meaningful, alternative pathway forward. As we continue to work with districts on

reentry planning, we see Homeboy as a critical community partner in making those transitions more successful.

- Dr. Perez highly encouraged the County Board to spend the morning at Homeboy.

Dr. Perez congratulated South Pasadena High School students that recently participated in a 2-day Youth Business Summit in New York City, bringing together thousands of rising young professionals, entrepreneurs, educators/school district administrators, business leaders and industry professionals from around the world for a one of a kind Global Convention. Dr. Perez said that the event included competitions, leadership events and professional networking opportunities for middle and high schools around the world to highlight their professional and business skills developed by running a virtual enterprise company. Dr. Perez recognized especially Diego L., her step son and a South Pasadena High School junior, who competed in the sales pitch competition and was awarded world champion for his sales pitch, from among a thousand student competitors. She congratulated him.

RECOGNITION OF THE 2025 LOS ANGELES COUNTY ACADEMIC DECATHLON CHAMPION ALHAMBRA HIGH SCHOOL TEAM FOR THEIR ACHIEVEMENTS IN THE CALIFORNIA ACADEMIC DECATHLON

The County Board and Deputy Superintendent recognized the 2025 Los Angeles County Academic Decathlon Champion Alhambra High School team. They also recognized the individual decathletes for their participation and achievements in the California Academic Decathlon, which is one of LACOE's competition programs that promotes academic excellence. The Alhambra High School Team came in 1st place, and is one of 6 schools from the Los Angeles County, that qualifies for the statewide Academic Decathlon competition. PUBLIC HEARING ON INTRODUCTION TO ETHNIC STUDIES COURSE OVERVIEW

Pursuant to Education Code Section 51225.3, a public hearing regarding the introduction to Ethnic Studies course overview took place. REPORT ON INTRODUCTION TO ETHNIC STUDIES COURSE OVERVIEW

Dr. Maricela Ramirez, Chief Academic Officer and Dr. Diana Velasquez, Executive Director of Special Programs Support and Transformation, provided the report to the County Board.

The County Board had questions regarding this item.

Ms. Breslauer requested a copy of syllabus / curriculum / textbook. Ms. Breslauer said she would like to know what is being taught in the Micro Certification Course.

Dr. Montano made the following comment: *"First of all, I am ethnic studies. I live ethnic studies. Ethnic studies is my life. And so, whenever I see anything coming in front of me, related to ethnic studies, I scrutinize it. I just want to say congratulations as I look through what you've done. You've aligned it perfectly with the model curriculum. You use the only approved text for ethnic studies at the present time, which is Takaki's a Different Mirror. The fact that you used it, and that you now have an A to G approved course, when many districts haven't even gone that far. As I look at each of your pages and I look at the four themes in the model curriculum, they fit perfectly with what is in the model curriculum, the focus groups. 0.7% over 12,000 hours is what the seat time that a student has for ethnic studies to study 4 separate disciplines in a state that is 74% like them. You sit there for 0.7%, and you get one course that covers who you are, and you've done an exemplary job in doing that. The focus on African American, Latino, Chicano, Native American, Asian, Pacific Islander, all aligned not just to the model curriculum, but to the disciplines that align ethnic studies. As I look at your sample lessons, it's clear to me that you cover all 4 disciplines; and that within each of those 4 disciplines you have great lessons, and then I assume that your teachers, as they're involved in the micro credentialing and in the program, are developing their own lessons. As I look at the fact that you have a micro credential and that you're focusing on professional development right now, all you need is a social studies, credential and English credential to teach ethnic studies, and you can go through the entire educational system in higher education and not take a single course, right? Many districts are not concentrating on providing micro credentials and professional development to teachers to teach ethnic studies and LACOE is. Therefore, I just have to say congratulations."*

The Superintendent recommends that the County Board approve the disposal of public personal property. Surplus assets will be disposed of through e-waste, recycled, or public auction, whichever method is most constructive.

Education Code Section 17545 authorizes the governing board to sell or dispose of surplus personal property. Any personal property not required for school purposes, unsuitable or unsatisfactory for school use or to be disposed of due to replacement, may be disposed in this manner. E-waste will be donated to *human-i-t*, an organization that recycles and sells parts and then utilizes funds to provide discounted new devices to low-income families.

E-waste and recycle property to be disposed of may include unusable:

Equipment – Vehicles, Projectors, Typewriters, Fax Machines, Computers, Monitors, Printers, Camcorders, VCRs, Bulbs, Furniture, Stoves, Microwaves, and Old/Obsolete items, etc.

A. Approval of the Introduction to Ethnic Studies Course Syllabus and Textbook

The Superintendent recommends that the County Board approve the Introduction to Ethnic Studies Course syllabus and textbook, A Different Mirror for Young People: A History of Multicultural America by Ronald Takaki. Ethnic Studies is a course requirement for the high school graduating class of the 2029-30 school year.

Ethnic Studies will be a one semester course, which aims to enhance students' understanding of diverse cultural perspectives. Through this course, students will gain skills, such as critical thinking and analytical skills, that are essential for navigating a diverse society by engaging with varied perspectives that examine the history, culture, and contributions of various ethnic groups, particularly those that are historically underrepresented.

As required by Assembly Bill 101, the Board of Education held a Public Hearing on April 15, 2025, to receive public comments on the Introduction to Ethnic Studies course overview.

Introduction to Ethnic Studies Course Description

This ethnic studies course develops student understanding that race and racism, white supremacy, colonialism, settler colonialism, and intersectional marginalization have been, and continue to be, profoundly powerful social and cultural forces in American society. The course focuses on the experiences and contributions of African Americans, Asian Pacific Islander Desi Americans, Chicana/Latinx, and Native Americans in the US. Course materials and activities are grounded in the concrete situations of Native people and people of color and use a pedagogical framing that emphasizes the structural dimensions of oppression, racial trauma and community cultural knowledge associated with cultural and ancestral knowledge that has sustained the resilience of the aforementioned groups.

The major purpose of this course is to educate students to be politically, socially, and economically conscious about their personal connections to local and national history, with a focus on themes of social justice, social responsibility, and social change. The course spans past to present, politics to social reform, and facilitates student identification of similar social patterns and universal qualities present in other societies, including their

own. The course will focus on the experiences of African America, Asian, Pacific Islander, Desi Americans (APIDA), Chicanx/Latinx, and American Indians. This course integrates community building/identity activities and study where students are encouraged to consider concepts related to their own personal, group, and/or identity.
