FAFSA	N/A	Free Application for Federal Student Aid for college or graduate school. https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa
CADAA	N/A	California Dream Act Application required to determine financial aid for California AB 540 eligible students. https://www.csac.ca.gov/post/resources-california-dream-act-application
AB 540	N/A	California Nonresident Tuition Exemption exempts certain students from paying nonresident tuition (higher than resident tuition) and/or allows them to apply and receive state aid at certain California public and private colleges. https://www.csac.ca.gov/post/california-nonresident-tuition-exemption
Chafee App	Y, N, No Data	The California Chafee Grant is free money for current or former California foster youth to help pay for college or career and technical training. Students must be current or former foster youth (have been in foster youth between the ages of 16 and 18), not have reached their 26 th birthday as of July 1 of the award year, and not have participated in the program for more than 5 years (consecutive or cumulative). Last qualifying challenge date is June 17, 2022.</p> <p>Value Definition: Yes – Application received on time with an Expected Family Contribution (EFC)</p> <p>No_EFC – Application received but EFC is blank due to App issues. The application errors do not allow the FAFSA to be processed or the EFC to be determined. Follow up with student to correct errors to ensure student can get financial aid.</p> <p>Late – Date application received is after the priority date.</p> <p>None – No application found</p> <p>No Data - Pending refresh from WebGrants into the Online Reports application</p>
Cal Grant Award	Y, N, No Data	<p>Current student CalGrant Status</p> <p>Value Definition: Y – Student has been awarded the CalGrant</p> <p>N – Student <i>has not yet</i> been awarded the CalGrant</p> <p>No Data - Pending refresh from WebGrants into the Online Reports application</p>

FAFSA/CADAA Completed	Yes, No, No Data	<p>FAFSA/CADAA Application has been submitted</p> <p>Value Definition: Yes – FAFSA/CADAA Application has been submitted. The FAFSA/CADAA App value is “Yes”, “No_EFC”, or “Late”. No – FAFSA/CADAA Application <i>has not yet</i> been submitted. The FAFSA/CADAA App value is “None”. No Data - Pending refresh from WebGrants into the Online Reports application</p>
Include in Challenge Count	Yes, No, ExitEarly, No Data	<p>Status based on factors such as number of days enrolled in your county or completion of FAFSA while in care, in your county. All eligible students enrolled in your county for at least 30 cumulative days AFTER October 1st must be included in your Total Foster Youth count for a given reporting period.
