Eligible Students are:

- Between ages of 5 -21
- Attending a school within Los Angeles County
- Under the jurisdiction of Los Angeles County Dependency Court/DCFS
- And/or under the jurisdiction of the Los Angeles County Delinquency Court/Probation

Non - Eligible Students are:

- Receiving services from Regional Center
- Kin-GAP

Submitting a Tutoring Referral

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WHO CAN SUBMIT A REFERRAL



- Generally, students residing within LA Unified School District boundaries and in a short-term residential therapeutic program (STRTP) receive services from the district.
- Email: asap@lausd.net

PRIOR TO SUBMITTING A REFERRAL

Contact the caregiver to ensure:

- student's interest in services.
- caregiver support of services.
- the student isn't already receiving services from another program.
- this is not a consumer of the Regional Center.

Once you have verified this information then you may proceed to submit a referral.

ACADEMIC SUPPORT SERVICES

Academic support services are available to students in foster care or those on probation via LACOE's Foster Youth Services Coordinating Program.

The 2024 - 2025 online tutoring referral is open.

Referrals are submitted online through our FYS tutoring site (see reverse side for instructions). Eligible students may receive up to 21 hours of in-home, one-on-one tutoring each school year.

REQUIRED INFORMATION

The following information is required to submit a tutoring referral:

- **Caregiver Contact Information and Consent**
- **Student Information:** name, date of birth, gender, grade level and courses
- **Placement Type:** and if applicable, the name of the STRTP/group home, or foster family agency
- **Court Status:** open Juvenile Dependency (WIC 300); open Probation/Delinquency (WIC 602); Dual Supervision; or Non-Minor Dependent
- **Los Angeles County Representative Contact Information:** Children's Social Worker (CSW) and/or Los Angeles County Juvenile Probation Officer (PO) information
- **County Office Name**

Please Note:

Requests for higher-level courses require proof of coursework prior to services being provided.

Missing or incorrect information will delay the referral process.

TUTORING REFERRAL PROCESS

Step 1: Visit our [webpage](#) or scan the QR code to submit a referral



Step 2: Click on the Submit a Referral icon

Enter student's DOB (MM/DD/YYYY), gender, last name, and first name.



Step 3: Click on the student's name when it displays, or click on the Add New Referral button.



Step 4: Complete all required fields .

- You must use the Google Chrome browser to submit a referral.
- Please be sure the student is seeking tutoring, or is aware that a tutor will meet with them.

TUTORING APPLICATION PROCESS

LACOE helps connect students in foster care that need additional academic support with tutoring resources.



Submit a Referral

2. Scroll down to locate *Submit a Referral*
3. Enter the student's name, date of birth and 10-digit SSID. Verify the correct name is populated and select
4. Complete the required information and click the *Next* button
5. Read the statement and click *Certify* to submit the referral
6. Once the tutoring referral is submitted, the referrer will receive a confirmation email

Check the following:

- You have entered the correct SSID
- You have entered the correct name
- You have the correct birthdate
- You are using Chrome as your browser
- You are logged out of EPS
- If this still does not work, email fys_tutoring@lacoed.edu

ASSIGNING A REFERRAL

- If a referral is considered incomplete, the referrer will receive an email from fys_tutoring@lacoe.edu requesting they submit a new referral
- Information is reviewed and assigned to a tutoring vendor
- Once the vendor receives the referral they will assign it to a tutor within 10 business days

REFERRAL STATUS

- **Submitted**
 - Pending assignment to tutoring vendor
- **Referred to Tutoring Vendor**
 - Assigned to a tutor
- **Referred to LAUSD**
 - STRTP within LAUSD boundaries
 - Contact asap@lausd.net if there are questions
- **Merged**
 - Duplicate referrals received
- **Completed**
 - Tutoring hours completed
- **Terminated**
 - Services refused by caregiver or student
 - Tutoring vendor unable to contact caregiver/household
 - Placement change leading to ineligibility **or** vendor unable to provide services
 - Student receiving tutoring from another source
 - If terminated, a Letter of Termination will be sent to either CSW or DPO **and** referrer

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Who qualifies?

A: Funding for Foster Youth Services can only be used for students:

- ages 5-21
- Attending a School within Los Angeles County
- residing within Los Angeles County
open DCFS/Dependency Court and/or open
probation/Delinquency Court Case

Q: What grade levels?

A: K - 12

(College students with open cases may receive tutoring if they continue to have an open case through the age of 21)

Q: How do you enroll?

A: A referral can be submitted online: [Tutoring Referral](#)



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Q: Is tutoring at school or at the child's home?

A: Tutoring typically occurs at the student's home. However, some exceptions can be made to allow the student to be tutored at a local library with **PRIOR** approval from LACOE FYS Tutoring.

Q: What subjects does LACOE tutoring cover?

A: Reading, Language Art and Math (Other subjects may be approved)

Q: Is the tutoring good for all school year?

A: A typical tutoring referral is approved for 21 hours per academic year. *(Additional hours may be approved on a case by case basis)*

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Q: Is tutoring virtual?

A: All tutoring is in person

Q: What is the provided area for services?

A: We provide tutoring throughout Los Angeles County

Q: How long is the help / how many hrs or minutes/ session?

A: 21 Hours total/ Maximum of 2 hours per session/2 sessions per week

Q: Once a referral is assigned to a vendor, how many times does the vendor/tutor try to contact student/guardian?

A: Typically, a vendor will try 3 times to contact the caregiver to initiate tutoring services.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: If a LACOE Foster Youth Direct Service Program Specialist made the referral, can the LACOE Foster Youth Direct Service Program Specialist receive notification that the referral was terminated.

A: If terminated, a Letter of Termination will be sent to either CSW or DPO and referrer

Q: Is this still open for college students?

A: Yes. As long as the student is not over the age of 21 and still has an open case..

Q: How do we connect students to this resource from our school site?

A: A referral can be submitted online: [Tutoring Referral](#)



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: How long does it take for a student to be connected to a tutor?

A: Once a referral is assigned, the student should be contacted within 10 business days.

Q: How do we get notified when we a student is assigned?

A: No notifications are issued, however you can use the view referral status option on EPS to stay up to date with the referral status.

Q: How can we check the priority and wait time?

A: You can use the view referral status option on EPS to stay up to date with the referral status.

Q: What if the School/STRTP do not appear on the drop down list?

A: Email FYS_Tutoring@lacoed.edu

Q: When do you stop accepting referrals?

A: We will continue to accept referrals as long as our budget allows. Once we have reached capacity the tutoring referral will no longer be available.
