# AB 2085 Mandated Supporter Training Implementation Plan

**AB 2085 Training Overview and Objectives:** Assembly Bill (AB) 2085 updated the definition of reportable general neglect in California beginning in January 2023. This course provides Mandated Reporters with an overview of the law, its impact on reporting practices in L.A. County and practical, family-centered strategies for making equitable decisions and supporting families when a report isn't legally required.
